

MEXICO CHECKLIST v. 26 May 2015

- 1) EAPIS (File for Departure and Arrival) Need all passport numbers, expiration dates, DOB's, addresses. Aircraft U.S. Customs Decal # N912LB 5521106; N2087F 5521105; N9216C 5521104. Take a copy of the email reply from CBP.
- 2) Aircraft Owner: Arizona Flyers Club Inc.
- 3) Address of aircraft: 3573 E. Sunrise Dr #233, Tucson 85718, Tel 1-520-299-0099
- 4) Mexico APIS - Baja Bush Pilots will handle for members only. Non-members can use the procedure offered by AOPA. See www.aopa.org/Flight-Planning/Mexico/Mexico-APIS-Procedures for email instructions. (fill in and email Excel form to: apis_cna@inami.gob.mx)
Note that you will not get a reply back on the email. Just take a copy of the email and spreadsheet. If feasible prior to departing Mexico, send the original email again (reply all to the original email).
- 5) File outbound and return flight plan w/ FSS
- 6) Notify Blaise for prop check
- 7) Arrival in Mexico - A/C Registration, Multi-entry permit, Mexico insurance, radio license?, Permission Letter from AZ Flyers (get from Blaise), Passport, pilot license and medical (a copy of all is good to have along)
- 8) File Mexico flight plan w/ Point of Entry (keep in possession)
- 9) PATIENCE! Allow at least one hour for entry into Mexico.
- 10) Survival gear, water
- 11) Dashboard sign "**TUCSON AERO HANGARS TENANT**" if parking outside TIA security premises.
- 12) Don't take fresh fruit or unpackaged food to Mexico or return
- 13) USA Entry - Contact Prescott Radio (122.4) 40mi south of border for squawk code, use Tucson approach from border (not ABQ CTR)
- 14) **Clear Customs upon return!!**
