Guidelines & Requirements

FINANCIAL-

Annual participating Pilot financial commitment **Payable to AZFC** with application

- \$50 per Pilot for each aircraft (Need 5 Pilots minimum per aircraft)
 - Covers Mexico flight liability insurance by Mexican insurer, U.S. customs decal, Mexico multi entry permit, etc.
- \$100 each Pilot / Contribution to AZFC – Maintenance Fund
 - Example: If 10-15 authorized Pilots/yr = \$1,000- \$1,500/yr contribution to a dedicated maintenance fund for exclusive benefit of AZFC participating aircraft.
- Flight damage deductible is responsibility of Pilot (same as domestic flights currently) secured by \$1000 stock holding of member Pilot
- \$20 per inspection: For each pre & post flight prop inspections by Blaise Richard or Mick Collins
- \$20 post trip aircraft clean-up charge (vacuum, etc.) charged to Pilot if required upon post flight prop inspection

CONTINUING EDUCATION & PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS

Established & monitored by Mexico Flight Committee appointed by Board

- 90 minute Mexico Flight Operations & Procedures Class by Mexico Flight Committee. Given annually or more often on demand. (Non-participating member pilots welcome! \$10 fee)
- Initial guided Mexico & Baja orientation trip for AZFC member pilots by Mexico Flight Committee Intro Baja adventure trip! (Multiple aircraft overnight guest AZFC member pilots welcome if seats available.)
- Initial committee: Tony Marrs, Lance Williams, Blaise Richard A&P, Mick Collins IA, CFI, plus additional members appointed by Board.
- Flight equipment Pilot checklist to include: survival list examples, flotation jackets, maps & guide books (Baja Bush Pilots "recommendations," U.S. Customs forms, etc.)
- Individual aircraft check-out by a designated "Mexico CFI"
- All Mexico flights landing destinations on list must be approved by Mexico Flight Committee
- C-182 RG Restricted to Government & Municipal Paved Airports (No unpaved airfields)
